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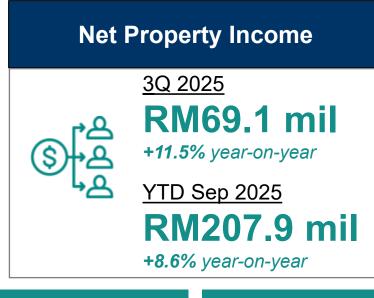

# **3Q 2025 Highlights**

#### **Organic Updates**

- Newly acquired Iskandar Puteri Facilities begins contributing income from 29 July 2025
- Successfully renewed an expiring lease at Valdor Logistics Hub at rental reversion of +20.8%
- Asset enhancement initiatives (AEI)
   in Gurney Plaza and 3 Damansara to
   refresh and elevate property appeal

#### **Inorganic Growth**

- Obtained beneficial ownership of Synergy Logistics Hub on 26 September 2025
- Including the completed acquisitions of Senai Airport City Facilities and Iskandar Puteri Facilities, enhanced logistics and industrial asset under management (AUM) to 7.9% of portfolio AUM (FY 2024: 2.8%)
- Collectively, these properties will strengthen portfolio income base in FY 2026

#### Sustainability

- CLMT improved its standing in the 2025 GRESB Real Estate Assessment, achieving its first 4star rating, one up from its 3-star rating last year
- Glenmarie Distribution Centre attained its LEED GOLD certification in October 2025
- As at 30 September 2025, ~RM2
   billion of credit facilities limit is under sustainability-linked financing, constituted 71.5% of loan portfolio

- The Placement was in line with CLMT's prudent capital strategy to optimise CLMT's financing ratio, providing financial headroom for future acquisitions while maintaining balance sheet flexibility
- A total of **RM250.0 million** was raised from this Placement exercise, enlarged units base by **409,836,000** new Placement Units issued at **RM0.61** per Unit
- Funds raised were used to repay bank borrowings and to lower CLMT's gearing level

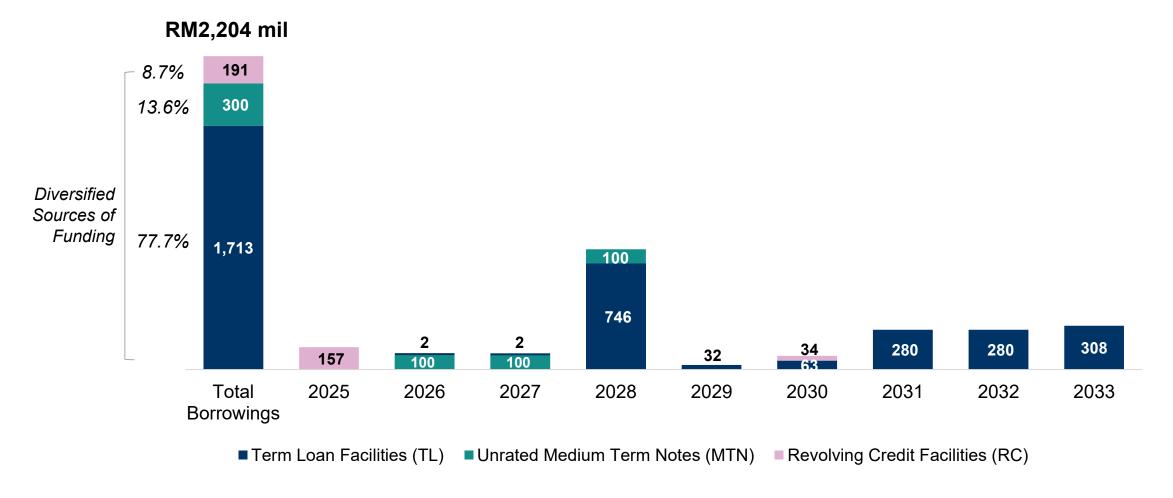

# **Well-spread Debt Maturity Profile**

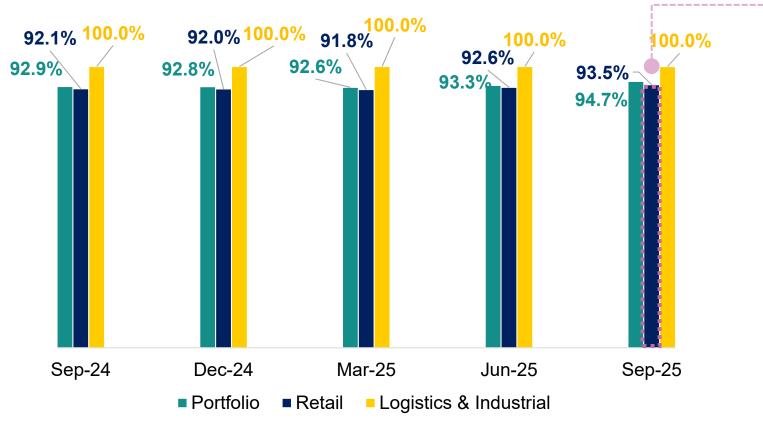

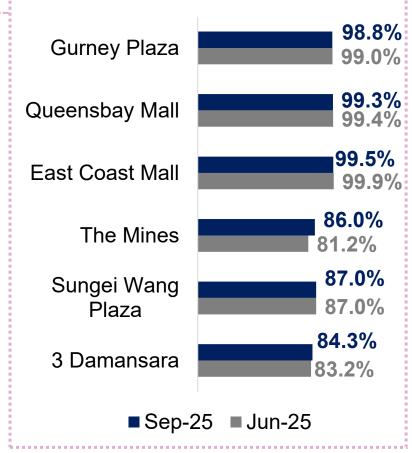




# **Portfolio Occupancy Rate**

The Mines and 3 Damansara recorded significant occupancy improvements with new food & beverage, fashion /accessories and sports/fitness offerings





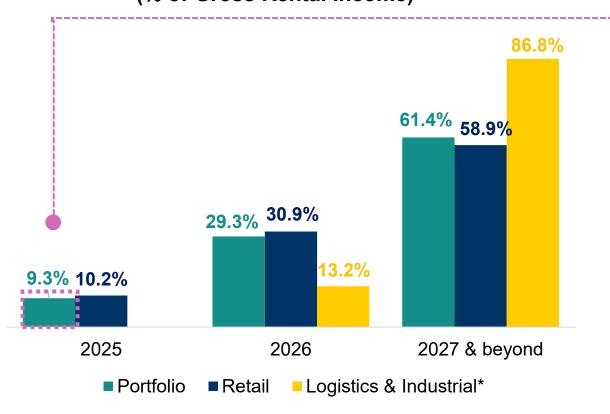

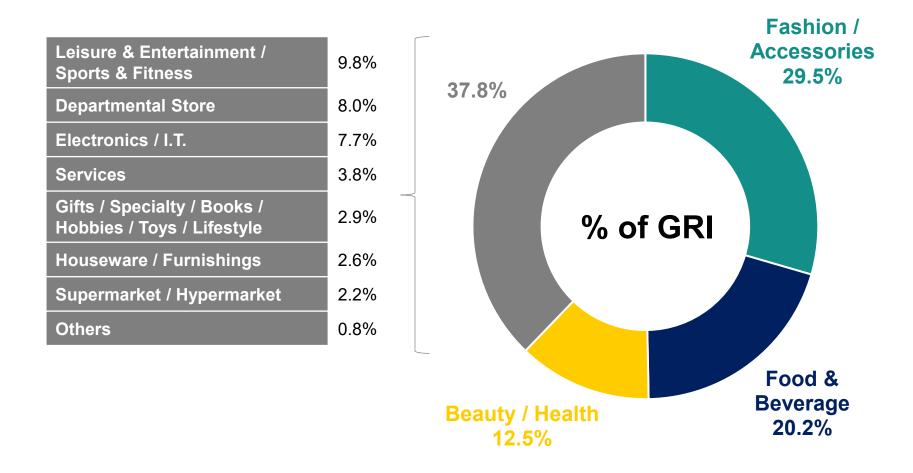

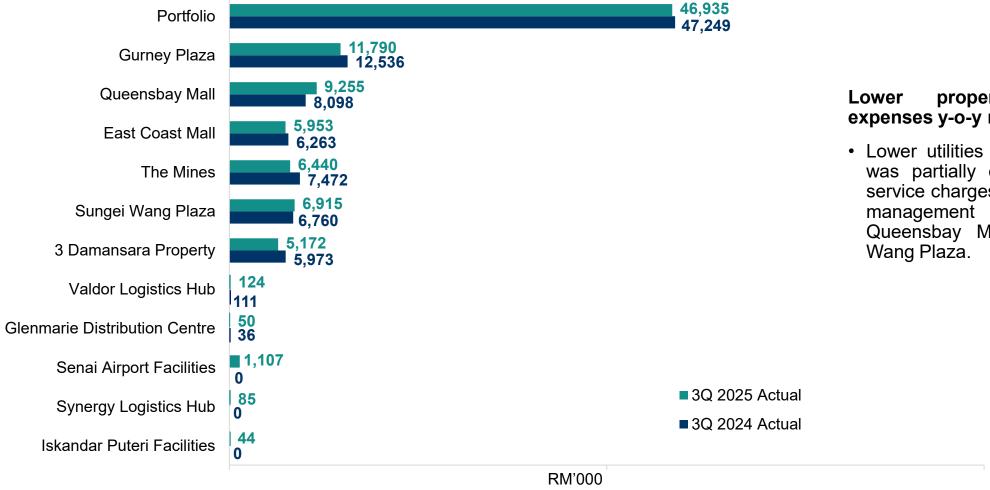

# **3Q 2025 Property Operating Expenses**

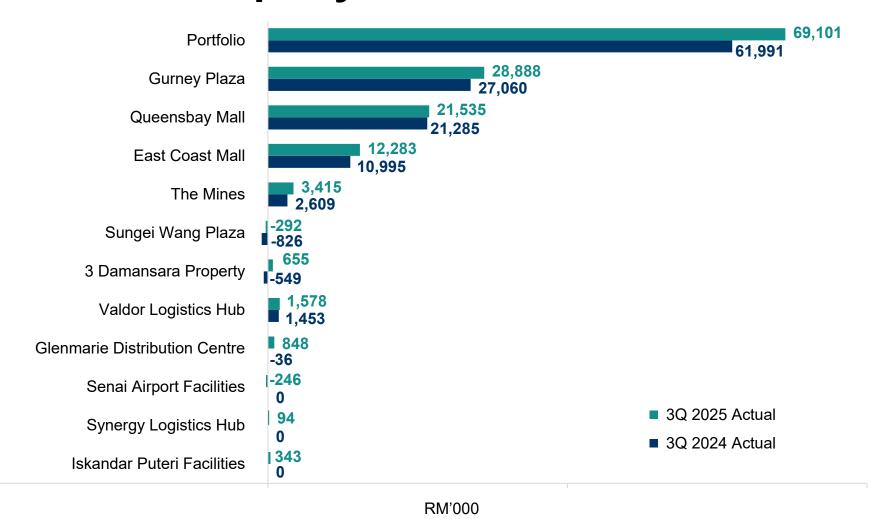

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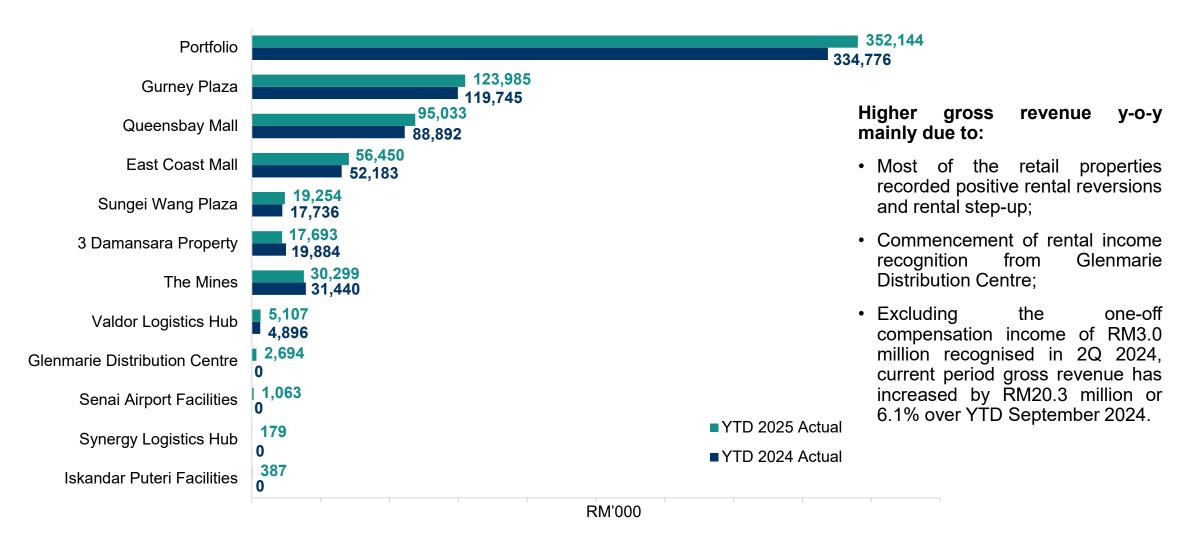
# **3Q 2025 Net Property Income**



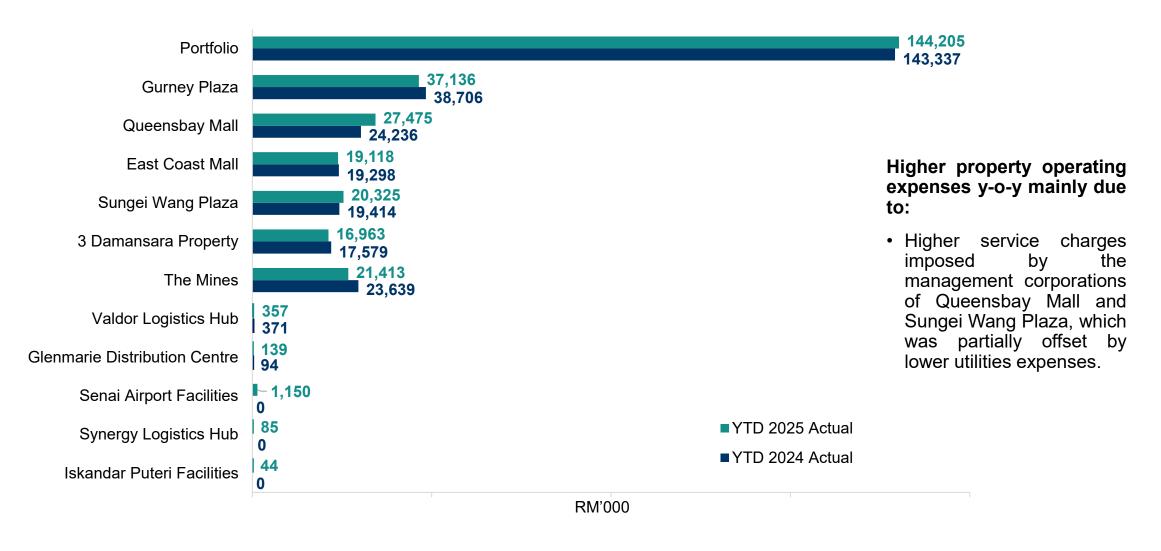

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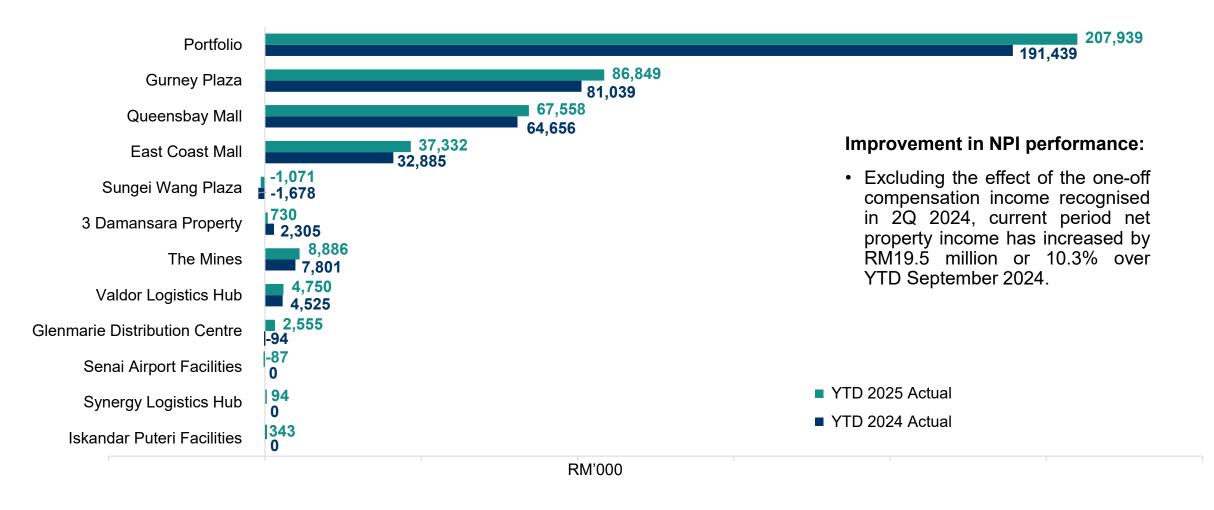
# YTD September 2025 Gross Revenue
